


**Addendum
Between
The State of Ohio
And
The U.S. Department of Agriculture
Commodity Credit Corporation
Concerning the Existing
Ohio Lake Erie Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program Agreement**

This Addendum Agreement is entered into between the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC), and the State of Ohio (together, "the Parties") in order to effectuate modifications to the above-captioned Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP) Agreement ("CREP Agreement") entered into on April 20, 2000 between USDA, CCC, and the State of Ohio. The CREP is part of the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), operated by the USDA's Farm Service Agency for CCC.

The parties hereby agree to amend the existing Lake Erie CREP Agreement under Federal Commitments to include:

1. The removal of CCC authority to provide a one-time wetland restoration incentive payment equal to 25% of the eligible reimbursable cost of restoring the hydrology of the site for acreage enrolled in practice CP23 or CP23A.
2. The CCC authority to make a one-time Practice Incentive Payment (PIP) for land enrolled in CP23 and CP23A, in accordance with normal procedure.


